Candidate Selection Process

1. Candidates are accepted from grades 10-12.
 - a) Sophomores must be in the fall of their 10th grade year; they cannot be candidates the summer before entering 10th grade.
 - b) Seniors can attend through the summer after their high school graduation.
2. Applications will be received beginning the day after completion of the previous TEC weekend.
3. Applications are selected on the following basis:
 - a) Those candidates who are recommended by their pastor or youth director as ones who would benefit from attending a particular weekend for valid reasons are accepted.
 - b) Any TEC candidates who applied for a TEC weekend previously but were not accepted or were unable to attend are put on a waiting list and receive first priority.
 - c) Applications are dated when received and the earlier applications receive priority.
 - d) The following people may receive special priority:
 - 1) Those young people who have only one more chance to attend a TEC weekend (high school seniors; or those moving out of the area).
 - 2) Those candidates representing a new school, city or church.
